## **Direct use/Purpose Statement (50 words):**

This lesson provides ELLs with a current, engaging audiovisual resource (news video clip) to supplement texts addressing the theme "knowledge opens doors." It can also be used as a standalone piece to build listening comprehension and oral communication skills. The students will generate vocabulary words, ideas and questions for the K and W parts of a KWL chart prior to watching the video clip; they will complete a GIST activity while listening, then work with a partner to discuss and summarize the clip. As a closure activity, students will return to their chart and complete the L – what we have learned - section.
